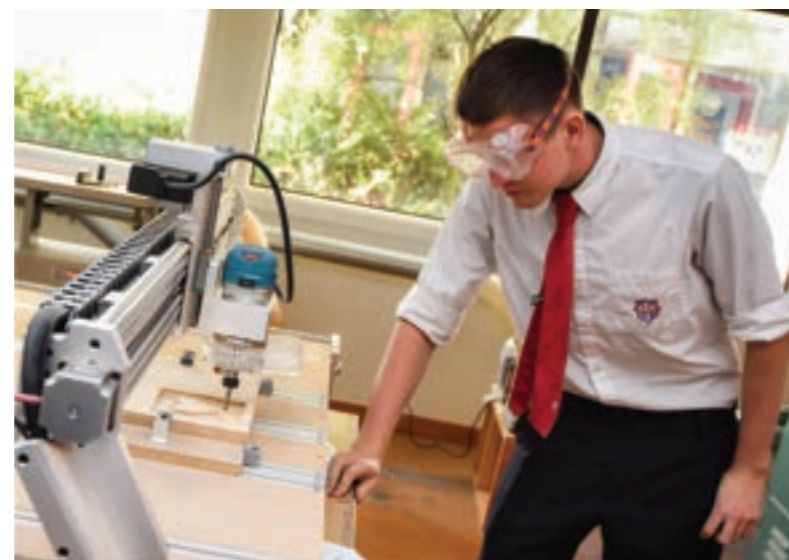
In addition to the academic curriculum; Trinity Catholic College offers an extensive and engaging range of sporting, arts, cultural and outdoor opportunities, activities and trips.
